INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLER: THESE INSTRUCTIONS CONTAIN IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION AND MUST BE FORWARDED TO THE BOAT OWNER.

THIS IS A REPLACEMENT PART FOR THE BALL POST AND CLAMP BLOCK ASSEMBLY IN STEERING CONNECTION KITS SA27255, SA27256, AND SA27332, MANUFACTURED BY SEASTAR SOLUTIONS.

WARNING

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE BEGINING INSTALLATION. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS, OR INCORRECT ASSEMBLEY COULD RESULT IN STEERING FAILURE WITH SUBSEQUENT PERSONAL INJURY AND PROP-ERTY DAMAGE. IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE BEST PERFORMANCE, THE STEERING **OUTBOARD** MOTOR OR OUTDRIVE MUST BE INSTALLED AND LUBRICATIED AND THE TRIM TAB ADJUSTED IN AC-CORDANCE WITH THE MOTOR MANUFACTURER AND THE BOAT MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICA-TIONS. CHECK THE CONTENTS OF THIS KIT AGAINST THE PARTS LIST ON THIS INSTRUCTION SHEET. USE PARTS SUPPLIED ONLY AS INSTRUCT-**ED ON THIS SHEET. DO NOT SUBSTITUTE PARTS OR** COMPONENTS FROM OTHER STEERING MANUFAC-TURERS. THEY CAN CAUSE A SAFETY HAZARD FOR WHICH SEASTAR SOLUTIONS CANNOT ACCEPT RE-SPONSIBILITY.


PREPARATION FOR INSTALLATION


NOTE: DO NOT DISCONNECT CABLE FROM MOTOR OR LOOSEN CABLE COUPLER NUT FROM SUPPORT TUBE.

- 1. Mark location of old Clamp Block on Support Tube, then remove hardware attaching Clamp Block.
- 2. Carefully note orientation of old Ball Post (pointing up or down), then remove hardware attaching Ball Post to transom.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Attach new Ball Post (item 1) to transom with the post pointing in the same direction (up or down) as the original one. NOTE: DO NOT MOUNT SIDEWAYS. (See Figure 1). First, place Flatwasher (item 2) on Hex Bolt (item 3), then insert Bolt thru Ball Post base and hole in transom. Add Flatwasher (item 2) and thread on Lock Nut (item 4). Install the other three sets of hardware in same manner, and torque to 75 inch/pounds. DO NOT EXCEED 100 INCH/POUNDS.
- 2. Place Clamp Block Bracket (item 5) around the Support Tube in the location previously marked, and over the ball on the end of the Ball Post. (See Figure 2).





Insert two Hex Bolts (item 6) thru rear holes (next to Ball Post) as shown. Add one Flatwasher (item 7) to each Bolt, and thread on Lock Nuts (item 8). Torque hardware to 100 inch/pounds minimum. DO NOT EXCEED 130 INCH/ POUNDS.

Install hardware (items 6, 7, 8) in the front holes and torque to 100 inch/pounds minimum, DO NOT EXCEED 130 INCH POUNDS.

WARNING

HARDWARE MUST BE INSTALLED AND TIGHT-ENED IN THIS SEQUENCE. FAILURE TO DO SO COULD ALLOW CLAMP BLOCK TO PULL OFF BALL POST, RESULTING IN LOSS OF STEERING.

STEERING TRAVEL CHECK

With the steering wheel, operate the steering system fully in both directions to assure equal travel of motor. Should further adjustment be required, loosen Clamp Block hardware and slide Support Tube in the desired direction. Retorque hardware to specifications noted above.

FINAL MECHANICAL CHECKOUT

- Move the motor thru the normal operating positions (side to side and tilting up and down) to assure that no interference or restriction of movement exists.
- Check Coupler Nut attaching Steering Cable to Support Tube and all attaching hardware for security and re-torque if necessary.
- 3. Using the steering wheel, check for proper action of steering controls. Rotating the wheel clockwise (to the right) should cause the boat to turn to the right (starboard).

The installation in now complete.

WARNING

THE BOAT SHOULD BE OPERATED WITH CARE UNTIL THE STEERING SYSTEM HAS BEEN THOROUGHLY CHECKED OUT UNDER NORMAL OPERATING CONDITIONS TO INSURE THAT THE INSTALLATION IS CORRECT AND FUNCTIONING PROPERLY.

MAINTENANCE NOTES

1. AFTER A FEW HOURS OF OPERATION FOLLOWING INSTALLATION OF THIS KIT AND PERIODICALLY THERE-AFTER, RE-TORQUE ALL FASTENERS AND CHECK THE STEERING SYSTEM FOR SECURITY AND INTEGRITY.

WARNING

LOOSENING OR SEPARATION OF ONE OR MORE FASTENERS MAY CAUSE FAILURE OF THE STEERING SYSTEM, RESULTING IN PROPERTY DAMAGE AND PERSONAL INJURY.

2. INSPECT PERIODICALLY FOR CORROSION. ALL METAL PARTS MEET OR EXCEED APPLICABLE SPECIFICATIONS FOR CORROSION RESISTANCE. HOWEVER, WITH EXTENDED OPERATION UNDER EXTREME CONDITIONS, CORROSION MAY OCCUR AND AFFECTED PARTS SHOULD BE REPLACED.
